## Maycock clean sweeps Bank of Bermuda Foundation Bermuda Open

**Robert Maycock was unstoppable at the recent Bank of Bermuda Foundation Junior Open Championships taking both the Under 17 & 19 titles.**

Robert came through the under 17 draw easily brushing aside Tucker Franks and eventual Under 15 winner Kristian Muldoon to take the title. He was pushed considerably harder in the Under 19 event beating off strong challenges from two players from USA and then crushing local players Douglas Olson and Chris Sgobba to take the double win.

Robert wasn't the only local star taking on players from the rest of the world. Chris Stout was the eventual boys under 13 winner from a draw boasting 3 international entries, two from USA and the Columbian National under 13 champion.

The seeded players all had relatively easy matches in 1st round before the 1st major upset of the competition came with 5/8 seed Noah Browne knocking out the number 2 seed and Columbian star Daniel Peralta by three games to love. Noah continued his fine form into the

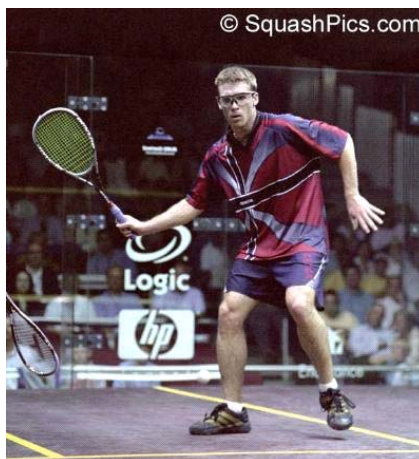
