Shrubb & Robinson take Allegro National Junior Titles

Michael Shrubb and Laura Robinson added the Bermuda Junior National Champion titles to the Caribbean titles they won in 2005.

The Allegro Insurance & Risk Management Junior Nationals took place 28th-30th December and received over 50 entries.

Michael Shrubb won the boys under 19 section without dropping a game although he was pushed extremely hard by Robbie Maycock who overcame the more experienced Andrew Stout in the semi finals. The Girls under 19 title was won by Caribbean Champion Laura Rob-

binson beating off strong opposition from Alex Furtado, Juliette McComb and Kelly Barnes.

Robbie Maycock made up for the disappointment in the under 19 final by taking the Under 17 championship. He finished ahead of under 15 champion Kristian Muldoon. The under 15 final proved to be one of the closest games of the tournament with Kristian Muldoon beating team mate Chris Stout 3-1 after a hard fought match.

The under 15 championship saw some other close matches with Noah Browne beating Jason Shrubb to 3rd place, Micah Franklin taking 5th place from Nicholas Brewer and Christopher Gerry finishing in 7th with a good win over Korin Knights.

Chris Stout beat Noah Browne 3-0 to win the boys under 13 title and in a nerve wracking finish to the boys under 11 championships Ryan Spencer Arscott beat off the challenge from Abraham D'Leon Saul and Laird Simmons to win the title.

The girls under 11 & 13 age groups were combined to play off together. Emma Keane, Alex Marshall and Jennifer Ince all did their best but were unable to stop Rachel Barnes from romping to the title.

the last Bermudian in the draw when she was beaten in girls under 13 event.

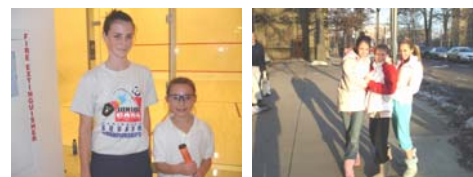

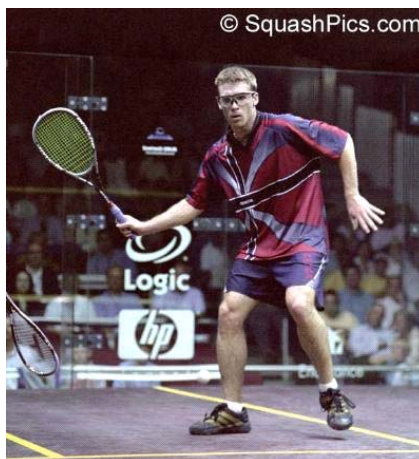
