Franklin & Hanekom BIAS Educational Champions 2006

Micah Franklin and partner Henri Hanekom won the BIAS Adult Child Educational Tournament 2006 beating National Squad training partner Noah Browne and Peter Barrett respectively.

The tournament held over 4 weekends include some 42 entries making up 21 teams. The ages of the juniors competing ranged from 6 to 12 years old with the adults needless to say, being considerably older!

The first three week of competition saw the teams battle in out in round robin draws. There were some unbelievably close matches with Kelly Barnes pushing Don Mackenzie hard, Douglas Olson making John Stout scramble the one game the team needed to win, Jennifer Ince scaring the life out of eventual winner Franklin, Jaques DeVerteuil going into a tie breaker with Ben Broughton and Emma Keane showing some great determination battling it out against 4 much older, larger boys in her group.

The group results were used to seed a

knock out draw held over the finals weekend of the competition. All 21 teams competed in 20 matches over 2 days eventually coming down to semi final match ups of William & Don Mackenzie against Noah Browne & Peter Barrett and Micah Franklin & Henri Hanekom against Jason Shrubbs and Stephen Smith. In 2 extremely close hard fought games Franklin and Hanekom overcame Shrubbs and Smith by a narrow margin

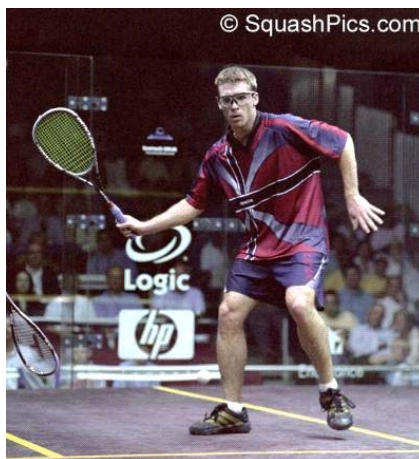
